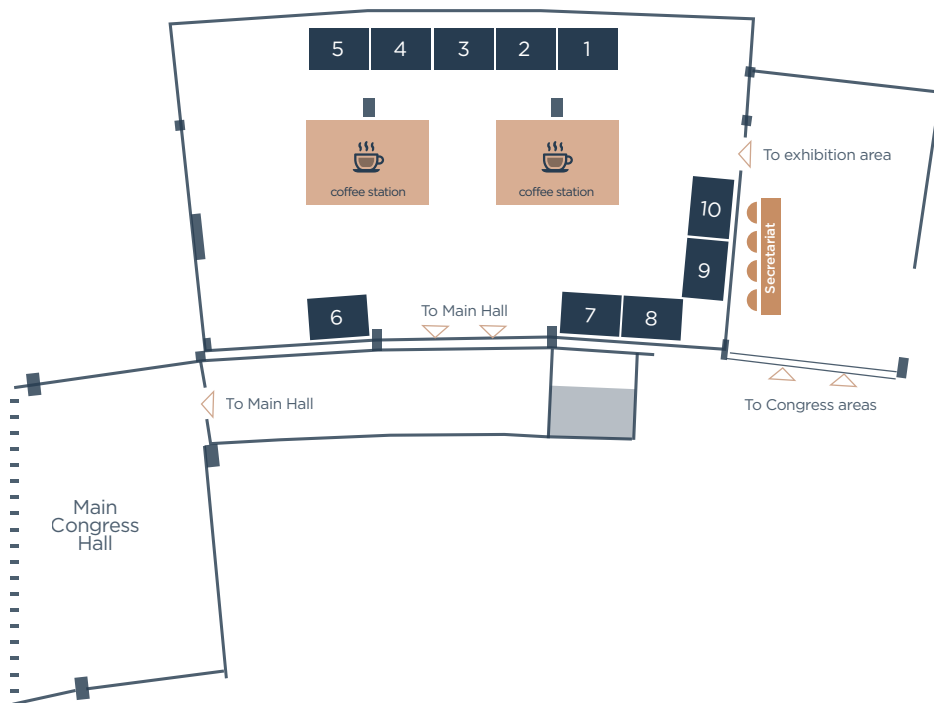
Awards For Best Oral & Poster Presentation
